Thank you for your enquiry regarding a place in the Sixth Form at Leicester Grammar School for September 2019.

Admission of students to the Sixth-Form is at the absolute discretion of the School. We will normally expect to admit an applicant if he or she:

- has chosen a subject combination that is both coherent and realistic considering achievements at GCSE; and
- demonstrates a positive attitude to study, the School and all that is has to offer; and
- has attained a minimum of three GCSEs at Grade 7 or better accompanied by a minimum of three further GCSEs at Grade 6 or better

During the 'mixed economy' years when students may receive a combination of new style 9 – 1 Grades along with A* – G grades, the School will consider Grades A*, A and B at par with Grades 8, 7 and 6 respectively. The School considers Grades attained in GCSE equivalent courses, such as IGCSEs, at par with their GCSE equivalents.

Applicants will be asked:

- 1 To produce a recent report from their present school;
- 2 To produce evidence other than this of likely performance at GCSE (this could take the form of mock GCSE results);
- 3 To attend a selection day at the School on Friday 8th March 2019.

On the basis of this evidence, we may award either an unconditional place for September 2019 or a place which is conditional upon certain GCSE grades being obtained. Prospective students in receipt of a conditional offer will be required to inform the School of their grades on GCSE Results Day (or, in exceptional circumstances, at a later date that has previously been agreed) and will be required to provide official confirmation of these results at Sixth Form Induction at the beginning of their first term.

Those entering the Sixth Form will have the advantage of small classes; teaching from well-qualified, specialist and experienced teachers; a great deal of individual attention via our personal tutors system; close pastoral care and guidance over choices for higher education and a wide array of extra-curricular activities.
