

# Drama Scholarship Information

For entry in September 2026



## For entry in September 2026

Candidates who join the school in Year 7-10 and wish to apply for a Drama Scholarship should do so as part of their application for entry to LGS. Drama scholarships are also available at the start of Year 12, either to existing LGS pupils or to external applicants.

Successful candidates for a Drama Scholarship must also have achieved the academic entry requirements for the school. Each scholarship consists of a fee reduction at the discretion of the Headmaster, this will either last from the point of entry to Year 11, or for the duration of Sixth Form, as appropriate. The scholarship will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Headmaster and Director of Drama.

Drama scholars will be supported with invitations to performances and opportunities to take part in specialist workshops to develop their skills. In addition, they will receive one-to-one support from the Director of Drama and members of the department to develop their practical and theoretical skills.



## How to apply for September 2026

### Year 7, 8, 9 and 10 Entry (external candidates only) and Sixth Form (external and internal candidates):

Candidates should complete the Drama Scholarship application form and provide as much detail as possible in regard to relevant specialist experience.

#### Year 7-10

The deadline for applications is **Monday 8 December 2025**. The application form will be reviewed by the Director of Drama and selected candidates will be invited to LGS for an audition workshop in January 2025 (date to be confirmed). The successful candidate(s) will be awarded the scholarship based on relevant experience, potential and skill displayed on the audition day.

### Year 12

The deadline for applications is **Friday 27 February 2026**. The application form will be reviewed by the Director of Drama and selected candidates will be invited to LGS for an interview that will involve an audition process in the Lent (Spring) Term 2026.

The successful candidate(s) will be awarded the scholarship based on relevant experience, interview and skill displayed on the audition day. Drama scholars will be expected to pursue Drama as one of their GCSE or A-level subjects (as appropriate). They are also expected to commit to co-curricular activities, including participating in school productions and trips.
