## into Year 12 in September 2026

Candidates who are new to the school and wish to apply for a Sports Scholarship should do so as part of their application for entry to LGS.

- Successful candidates for Sporting Scholarships must also have achieved the academic entry requirements for the Sixth Form.
- Current LGS pupils may also apply for a Sports Scholarship.
- Potential candidates will be shortlisted for assessment by the Director of Sport.
- Each scholarship consists of a fee reduction at the discretion of the Headmaster for the duration of their time at school.
- The scholarship will be reviewed on an annual basis by the Headmaster and Director of Sport.
- The emphasis for sporting scholarship at this entry point is 'Outstanding Sporting Excellence' and what candidates may potentially contribute to the school's major games.

For the purpose of Sixth Form Sports Scholarships, the school's major games are:

## How to apply for Year 12 in September 2026

Candidates should apply in writing, including evidence of their sporting ability, a sporting CV and any references to support their application.

It is anticipated that applicants will have gained selection to at least County/ Regional level in one of the school's major games or more, or have equivalent accreditation.

Arrangements will be made for shortlisted candidates to be assessed either at their existing school or at LGS.

Sports Scholars will be expected to fulfil all school sporting commitments for which they are selected across all three school terms, including a full commitment to our weekend fixture programme and be ambassadors for the department, school and wider community.
