1. USE YOUR BRAIN

AI can help you understand topics or improve your work, but it should not do the work for you. Always think critically about the content that is produced, it might not be accurate.

2. AVOID PLAGIARISM

Plagiarism is the act of submitting somebody else's work as your own. This includes AI-generated work. You must not use AI for any part of your NEA for GCSE or A-level. The rules will be made clear by your teachers. Always follow these rules.

3. FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS

Only use AI in line with this document and the traffic lights system. Follow any specific instructions that your teacher gives for each piece of work. Only use the AI tools that you have been told to by your teacher.

4. BE HONEST

Declare when you have used AI to help you with a piece of work and explain how you used it. Do not try to pass off AI-generated work as your own.

5. PROTECT YOUR PRIVACY

Never share personal information (like your full name, address, or school details) with AI tools.

6. STAY SAFE

Do not use AI to create or search for inappropriate, harmful, or offensive content. As convincing as they can seem, remember that AI tools are not real people. Do not treat them as friends.
