Instrumental Tuition 2023-2024

Leicester Grammar School offers pupils the opportunity to have instrumental music lessons within school. These lessons are provided by our superb team of resident and visiting teachers.

Pupils' lessons rotate through their timetable so that they do not miss the same lesson more than once per half term. In the interests of fairness, the rotation system must be the norm in both the senior and junior schools. There are a few exceptions to this:

- Pupils in Year 11 have first priority for fixed lesson slots before and after school, in break and at lunchtime.
- Sixth form pupils should be able to fix their lessons in a free period.
- Pupils who learn more than one instrument in school should have one lesson in a fixed slot.


A key responsibility of pupils is to communicate politely with their class teacher when they have a timetabled instrumental lesson that means they will miss part or all of the class lesson. This must be done at least a week in advance so that any contingency plans can be made for catching up on the work – and as a matter of courtesy.

Instrumental teachers invoice parents directly for the cost of lessons (£22.00 from September 2023 for a 30-minute weekly lesson).

If you would like your child to receive tuition during the coming academic year, I would be grateful if you would complete the form overleaf and return it to the Music Office.

By completing the form, you are consenting to the school passing your contact details to the relevant instrumental teacher as named. That teacher will contact you directly with further information.
