**Muslim Prayers:** See the Chaplain for more information if you want to gather with other Muslim students and staff to pray corporately at lunchtimes. It is also recognised that Monday March 10th marks the beginning of the solemn period of **Ramadan**.

**Chapel Chocolate:** A variety of different events, simply a drink and chat, or a discussion on some topic, or very simple accessible services. A chance for pupils to stay in school after lessons to have some time out.

**Christian Union:** An opportunity for pupils, both Christians and those exploring the faith, to gather in an informal setting and find out about the Christian faith, through talks, videos, presentations and Bible study. Refreshments and games are also on offer.

**Lunchtime prayers:** A short service, open to all, including some formal and informal times of prayer and Bible readings.

**Confirmation Classes** are available for members of the Church of England who wish to be confirmed. These would normally take place in the Lent Term.
